LANDSCAPING AND GROUND MAINTENANCE CONTRACT

This agreement, made up of four (4) components: Landscaping and Grounds Maintenance Contract, General Conditions, Request for Proposal and Proposal Response Form, made this _____ day of _____ 2021, by and between (1) The City of Orangeburg, Department of Public Utilities, acting herein through its (2) Manager, hereinafter called "Owner", and (3) _____, doing business as a partnership/a corporation/an individual (strike out in applicable terms), with its principal office in the City of Orangeburg, County of Orangeburg, State of South Carolina, hereinafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the payments and agreements hereinafter mentioned, to be made and performed by the Owner, the Contractor hereby agrees with the Owner to commence and complete the work described as follows: Landscaping and Grounds Maintenance as described on the Proposal Response Form.

The Contractor further agrees to commence and complete any and all work in connection with the said project and at his (its or their) own proper cost and expense to furnish all material, machinery, equipment, tools, labor, insurance, and other accessories and services necessary to complete the said project in accordance with the General Conditions and at the prices stated in the Proposal Response Form and this Contract.

The Contractor hereby agrees to commence work under the Contract on October 1st, 2021 and shall run for 12 consecutive months ending on September 30th, 2022. This contract will auto renew each year on October 1. Either party may cancel the contract by giving sixty (60) days written notice prior to the requested cancelation date. Any changes in the scope of work or the payment terms must be detailed and approved by both parties using the attached standard change order form.

The Owner agrees to pay the Contractor in US dollars for the performance of the Contract, as per the proposal(s) (attached hereto) subject to additions and deductions, as provided in the General Conditions, and to make payments on account thereof. The General Conditions and Proposal(s) are attached hereto and are a part of this Contract by reference.

Contractor's Address

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Definitions - The following terms as used in this contract are respectively defined as follows:
 - A. Contractor - a person, firm or corporation with whom the contract is made by the Owner.
 - B. Subcontractor - a person, firm or corporation supplying labor and/or materials for work at the site of the project for and under separate contract or agreement with the Contractor.
 - C. Work on the Project - work to be performed at the location of the project by employees of the Contractor or Subcontractor.
 - D. Owner - the City of Orangeburg, Department of Public Utilities (DPU).
 - E. Dormant Season – the months of December, January and February
 - F. Peak Season – the months of March, April, May, June, July, August September, October, and November
2. Scope of the Work - The Contractor is to provide the Department of Public Utilities full grounds maintenance that keeps the outside appearance of the Main Office neat and attractive at all times.
 - A. The Contractor shall, in good workmanlike manner, do and perform all work and furnish all labor, supplies and materials, machinery, equipment, facilities and means, except as herein otherwise expressly specified, necessary or proper to perform and complete all the work required by this contract in accordance with the items identified on the Bid Form.
 - B. There shall be no smoking on any DPU property at any time whatsoever.
 - C. At no time should Contractor or any of his employees enter any DPU building without being accompanied by a DPU employee and work may not be subcontractor without written permission from the DPU.
3. Laws and Regulations - The Contractor shall keep himself informed of all laws, ordinances and regulations of State, City and County in any manner affecting those engaged or employed in the work or in any way affecting the work. He shall at all times observe and comply with all such laws, ordinances and regulations and shall protect and indemnify the Owner against any claims or liability arising from or based on the violation of any such law, ordinance or regulation.

4. Changes in Work – No changes in work covered by the approved contract documents shall be made without having prior written approval of the Owner. Charges or credits for the work covered by the approved change shall be determined by one or more, or a combination of the following methods:
 - A. An agreed lump sum.
 - B. The actual cost of:
 - 1) Labor
 - 2) Materials entering permanently into work.
 - 3) The ownership or rental cost of equipment during the time of use on extra work.
5. Payments to Contractor - Payments to Contractor shall be made according to the following:
 - A. Not later than the 15th of each calendar month the Owner shall make a payment to the Contractor on the basis of a duly certified approved invoice of the work performed during the preceding calendar month provided that the Contractor provides the Owner with said invoice no later than the 10th day of the month.
6. Insurance - The Contractor shall procure and maintain during the life of this contract, whether such operation be by himself or by subcontractor or anyone directly or indirectly employed by either of them, such insurance as required by statute and/or ordinance to adequately protect the Owner from any claims or damages, including bodily injury or death, which may arise from them during operations under this contract.

Limits of Liability - Insurance shall be obtained for not less than the limits as follows:

- A. **Workmen's Compensation Insurance:** for all employees in an amount not less than \$500,000.00 (including subcontracted employees) to be employed in the course of this work.
- B. **Commercial General Liability Insurance:** The Contractor shall take out and maintain during the life of the Contract such commercial general liability insurance as shall protect him from any claims for damage for bodily injury, including accidental death, as well as claims for property damage, which may arise from operations under this contract in the amount as follows:
 - 1) Bodily injury and personal injury in an amount not less than \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence and subject to a limit of not less than \$1,000,000.00 during a period of twelve months.

- 2) Property damage in an amount not less than \$500,000.00 for any one damage claim, and in an aggregate amount up to \$500,000.00 during a twelve month period.

C. Comprehensive Automobile Liability Insurance:

- 1) Includes coverage for all owned, hired and non-owned automobiles.
- 2) The combined single limit of liability shall not be less than \$1,000,000.00 for any one accident or loss.

- D. Excess Liability (Umbrella) Insurance:** Contractor shall carry and maintain Combined Excess Liability (Umbrella) insurance for an amount of not less than \$1,000,000.00 for each occurrence and \$1,000,000.00 aggregate.

Certificates of Insurance – The Contractor shall deliver to the Owner Certificates of Insurance prior to the execution of the Contract by the Owner and prior to commencing work showing the type, amount, class of operations covered, effective dates and dates of expiration of the policies. Such certificates shall contain substantially the following statement: “The insurance covered by this certificate will not be cancelled or materially altered except after 30 days written notice has been received by the owner”.

7. E-Verify - The Contractor shall be required to sign the Contractors Affidavit and comply with all requirements of the South Carolina Illegal Immigration Reform Act.
8. Owner's Inspection - The Owner may at any time he deems appropriate, inspect the work in progress. The Owner may specify the order of the work to be performed.
9. Owner's Authority - The Owner shall determine the amount, quality, acceptability and fitness of the work under this contract. DPU shall decide all questions which may arise in relation to said work and the Owner's decisions shall be final and conclusive.
10. Right of Owner to Terminate Contract - In the event that any of the provisions of the contract are violated by the Contractor or by any of his subcontractors, the Owner may serve written notice upon the Contractor of intention to terminate the contract. Within ten days from the date of the mailing of such notice, the Owner may take over the work and prosecute the same to completion. The Contractor shall be given an opportunity to correct any deficient provision during the ten days.

11. Right to Terminate Contract by Either Party –The Owner and the Contractor reserve the right to terminate this contract after giving sixty (60) days written notice of its intention to do so.
