

Student Council Resolutions

_____ **School**
_____ **School Year**

Student Council will support the following clubs with collection of money earned from fundraisers and payment of expenses for the _____ school year. Student Council also approves these clubs to pay for reward parties, field trips and related transportation and food costs for field trips: Band, Choir, ID's, NJHS, Orchestra, PE, Student Council, Yearbook. Any new after school clubs that are formed will present their request to the Student Council with the club name and purpose.

Proposal 1: Band

The Student Council will approve the band instructor to collect monies from students for the music Jog-A-Thon and monies collected for club T-shirts from the music groups. Student Council approves payment for supplies purchased by band, expenses for field trips (including lunches), transportation costs and student awards.

Proposal 2: Choir

The Student Council will approve Choir to collect monies from the students for the music Jog-A-Thon and monies collected for club T-shirts from the music groups. Student Council approves payment for supplies purchased by Choir and approves payment for field trip expenses (including lunches), student awards/trophies and transportation costs.

Proposal 3: Orchestra

The Student Council will approve Orchestra to collect monies from the students for the Practice-A-Thon and monies collected for club T-shirts from the music groups. Student Council approves payment for supplies purchased by Orchestra, expenses for field trips (including lunches), student trophies/awards and transportation costs. Student Council also approves fundraisers and payments for expenses for the annual Disneyland performance trip in May pending board approval.

Proposal 4: ID's

The Student Council will approve the purchase of and payment for supplies/materials such as badge cards, pouches and lanyards to produce the student ID'S and the collection of monies from the students paying for a second, third etc. ID card. Funds collected are to be deposited in Student Activities bank account and to be spent on supplies for the ID's. After supplies have been purchased the extra amount should be used for schoolwide events such as reward events, assemblies and to fund approved new clubs. Prices are as follows: \$1- cardholder, \$1- lanyard and \$5 for card, holder and lanyard.

Proposal 5: NIHS

The Student Council will approve the collection of monies for the sale of dance tickets and concessions for NJHS sponsored event. Student Council also approves payment of supplies/materials for National Junior Honor Society activities, reward parties, annual registration fees, and purchase of year end rewards such as gift cards in the amount up to \$25 for outstanding members and the payment of field trips for National Junior Honor Society and associated field trip costs.

Proposal 6: PE

The Student Council approves payment for monies collected from students for PE uniforms to be deposited into Student Activity to purchase new uniforms. The Student Council also approves payment of sports equipment and purchase of trophies and rewards such as gift cards in the amount of up to \$25 each for 8th grade awards.

Proposal 7: Recycling Club

This proposal approves sponsorship of the Recycling Club. Proceeds from recycling will be deposited in the Student Council fund and used for student rewards and to benefit all students such as buying supplies for the student store.

Proposal 8: Student Council

Student council approves the collection of monies from students for dances and events held including tickets, concessions, flowers, candygrams, approved snacks sale, carnival and outside vendors. The funds collected from these dances are to be deposited to the Student Activity Student Council Club and will be used for all grade levels to have pizza parties, reward parties, quarterly rewards and year end awards for Student Council members and other school events. Student Council approves payment to disc jockey, security personnel and payment of any bills to furnish supplies needed for these dances and events. Student Council approves the Scholastic Book Fair held during Parent Teacher Conferences. Student Council approves the purchase and sale of spirit goods such as t-shirts, drink containers, sling bags, etc. to be sold to students for cash and/or Drive Dollars and also to be used as student rewards/incentives.

Proposal 9: Yearbook

The Student Council authorizes the deposit of monies and payment for the yearbook. Also approved are purchases such as cameras, film, computer software and the processing of film items necessary to collect data for the yearbook. These purchases will be made by the Yearbook Advisor. Also authorizes the deposit of monies collected from fundraisers, such as cookie dough sales, sale of pencils/erasers and other approved fundraisers. The Student Council also approves payment of expense for a yearbook field trip and associated expenses such as registrations and transportation fees.

Proposal 10: Year End Gift to School

This proposal provides that Student Activity funds may be authorized for purchases of gifts to the school so long as it benefits all students with monies earned by fundraisers throughout the school year. Such items may include a school marquee, commemorative benches/gardens, etc.

Proposal 11: Student Incentive Store

The Student Council approves the purchase of gift cards to be available for purchase with Drive \$'s in the student incentive store.
