Art Career Poster Scoring

Neatness: The overall impression should be that every attempt has been made to be neat. Mistakes are cleanly erased; it looks as if the student took care with the work. Writing is legible and straight.

Title & Illustrations: Title should be larger than the regular text and eye-catching. Two illustrations are present. Illustrations take up the entire space provided. Illustrations are attractive and eye-catching. Color is used to make the pictures and/or text stand out. A minimum of 4 colors are used (not including black and white) and they compliment each other.

Written explanation: All required question responses are present and there is sufficient depth of information present. All writing should make sense and be easy to read. Spelling is correct.
