Student Focused Goals:

- **Reading Goal:** By June 2020, Charter Day School will Meet or Exceed reading growth and will increase overall reading proficiency up to 5% from 74.3% (2017-18) to up to 79.3%, as measured by NC End-of-Grade testing.
- **Math Goal:** By June 2020, Charter Day School will Meet or Exceed math growth and will increase overall math proficiency up to 5% from 71.7% (2017-18) to up to 76.7%, as measured by NC End-of-Grade testing.
- **Teacher Retention Goal:** Charter Day School will work to close the teacher retention gap to within 5% of the traditional LEA where it is located as indicated in the Teachers Leaving the Profession Data annual report.
