Student Technology Use Agreement:

Lighthouse Education Center authorizes students to use technology owned or otherwise provided by the center as necessary for instructional purposes. The use of technology is a privilege permitted at the center's discretion and is subject to the conditions and restrictions set forth in applicable policies, administrative regulations, and this acceptable use agreement. The center reserves the right to suspend access at any time without notice for any reason.

The center expects all students to use technology responsibly in order to avoid potential problems and liability. The center may place reasonable restrictions on the sites, materials, and/or information that students may access through our WiFi system. Each student who is authorized to use technology and his/her parent/guardian shall sign this acceptable use agreement as an indication that they have read and understood the agreement. The center's technology includes but is not limited to computers, the computer network server and wireless computer networking technology, the internet, emails, USB drives, wireless access points, tablets, phones, wearable technology, and any wireless communication device including future technological innovations whether accessed on or off-site or personally owned equipment or devices.

Student obligations and responsibilities:

Students are expected to use the center's technology safely, responsibly, and for educational purposes only. The student in whose name the center's technology is issued is responsible for its proper use at all times. Students shall not share their assigned online services account information, passwords, or other information used for identification and authorized purposes and shall use the system only under the account to which they have been assigned.

Students are prohibited from using the center's technology for improper purposes including, but not limited to:

1. Access post display or otherwise use material that is discriminatory, libelous, obscene, sexually explicit, or disruptive.
2. Bully, harass, intimidate, or threaten other students, staff, or other individuals. (cyberbullying)
3. Disclose use or dissemination of personal information of another student, staff member or other person with the intent to threaten, intimidate, harass, or ridicule another person.
4. Infringe on copyright, licenses, trademark, patent, or other intellectual property rights.
5. Intentionally disrupt or harm centers technology or center operating systems.
6. Install unauthorized software.
7. "Hack" into the system to manipulate the center's system or another user's system.
8. Engage in or promote any practice that is unethical or violates any law, policy, or regulation

Privacy:

Since the center's use of technology is intended for educational purposes, students shall not have any expectation of privacy in any use of the centers technology. Lighthouse Education Center reserves the right to monitor and record all use of technology, including but not limited to, access to the internet or social media, communications sent or received, or other uses. Students should be aware that in most instances their use of technology cannot be erased or deleted.



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Personally Owned Devices:

If a student uses a personally owned device to access technology he/she shall abide by all applicable policies, administrative regulations, and this acceptable use agreement. Any such use of a personally owned device may subject the contents of the device and only communications sent or received on the device to disclosure pursuant to a lawful subpoena or public record request.

Reporting:

If a student becomes aware of any security problem or misuse of technology he/she shall immediately report such information to the teacher or center administrator/staff.

Consequences for Violation:

Violations of the law, policy, or this agreement may result in revocation of a student's access to technology and/or discipline, up to and including suspension or expulsion from the center. In addition, violations of the law, policy, or this agreement may be reported to law enforcement agencies as appropriate.

Student Acknowledgement:

I have received, read, understand, and agree to abide by this acceptable use agreement and other applicable laws and center policies and regulations governing the use of technology. I understand that there is no expectation of privacy when using center technology. I further understand that any violation may result in loss of user privileges, disciplinary action, and/or appropriate legal action.

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Computer, Telecommunications, and Network Resources:

The following guidelines and policies apply to:

- Students who use computers belonging to Lighthouse Education Center.
- Students who access network resources available at Lighthouse Education Center
- Students who bring personal devices to Lighthouse Education Center.

Network access, including the internet, is available to all students enrolled at Lighthouse Education Center. All students should have a designated GMail account assigned to them, with their Google Classroom account. Lighthouse Education Center also maintains contact information for appropriate communication business and to promote instruction and learning. Lighthouse Education Center has taken technical and organizational precautions to restrict access to controversial materials; however, on a shared network is it impossible to control all controversial materials. Lighthouse Education Center has restricted as much content as possible and is continuing to add restricted material as it becomes available.

Guidelines for Acceptable Use:

- Only devices approved for use by administrators may be connected to Lighthouse Education Center's network system.
- The network computers, telecommunications, and network resources are to be used for educational purposes only.
- Students shall not purposely submit, publish, display, or retrieve any defamatory, inaccurate, abusive, obscene, profane, threatening, sexually oriented, racially offensive, or illegal material.
- Students shall abide by all copyright and trademark laws and regulations
- Students shall not reveal personal information data unless authorized to do so by designated center staff.
- Students shall not reveal their personal login information or passwords to allow others to work using their information.
- Students shall not use the network in any way that would disrupt the use of the network by others, attempt to harm hardware, software, data nor interfere with the security of any computer network.

Privileges and Responsibilities:

The use of Lighthouse Education Center's computer telecommunications, and network resources are a privilege, not a right, and may be revoked at any time. Violations of this privilege may result in disciplinary action under the guidelines of its policies.
