Criteria for a Walk-Up Workshop –

- * Workshop to be presented at a designated walk-up workshop area on Friday and/or Saturday
- * 45-minute “flex flow” session
- * Demonstration format
- * Demonstration should be 20 minutes long (approximately) and could be repeated
- * 12 – 15 or more people (some standing)
- * No use of technology
- * Multi-level/all-level lesson
- * Handouts to be accessible by email, TAEA app or web site
- * Presenter has examples of the process at the various stages of the assignment
- * Presenter must be flexible since teachers will be walking up at various times during the presentation
