The Kalkaska County Road Commission will receive sealed proposals until 4:00 p.m. on Friday, November 9, 2012, at which time they will be opened and read aloud at the regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, November 12, 2012, at 9:30 a.m., for the construction engineering on the Innis Road Construction Project, from Plum Valley Road to the county line for approximately 1 mile in Rapid River Township. This is a federal-aid funded project. All FHWA standards must be followed.

Henry Diemer, Wilcox Professional Services, will be the Project Engineer. This Federal Aid Project will be let in a MDOT letting this winter with construction to begin in the spring of 2013.

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Project Facts

The project includes but is not limited to: hill cutting, drainage, stump removal, widening and paving of hot mix asphalt.

The existing surface is a rural gravel road. The new roadway will consist of 3" hot mix asphalt lanes and shoulders.

Henry Diemer, Wilcox Professional Services, will be the Project Engineer. This Federal Aid Project will be let in a MDOT letting this winter with construction to begin in the spring of 2013.

All Field Manager administration shall be included in the bid. Successful bidder will be required to provide all Field Manager administration including but not limited to: Filing, Inspector's Daily Reports, Material Certifications, Contract Modifications and Estimates. This will be required until project closeout.

The successful bidder will be responsible for all material testing including but not limited to: concrete, aggregates, and asphalt.

Successful bidder will be responsible for all staking for the project.

Successful bidder will coordinate and attend all required meetings, including but not limited to preconstruction meeting, and keep the Kalkaska County Road Commission informed on the project progress and notify the Kalkaska County Road Commission of any changes.

Bidders MUST fill out attached, "Construction Proposal Sheet". Proposals must be submitted in an envelope clearly marked, "Request for Proposal – Innis Road Construction Engineering Services", prior to 4:00 p.m. on Friday, November 9, 2012.
