



1. **CAST FEE** – As a participant in a children’s learning/mentoring program, children 18 years and younger will pay a \$80 cast fee to participate in this production. Siblings will be \$45. Cast Fee is due by June 15th, 2012.
2. **VOLUNTEERING** - In addition to cast fees, as a community theater we do require some volunteering.
 - a. We prefer parents or adult cast members to volunteer in at least one area, however small. Or invite a friend or family member to come help.
 - b. Volunteer positions:
 - i. Plan, or help plan the cast party
 - ii. Help build or paint sets
 - iii. Donate your truck to move sets and materials to and from our storage facility
 - iv. Assist with costumes or props
 - v. Poster Deliveries – deliver posters to our already location-organized routes
 - vi. Handing out flyers at various locations (ie King Soopers)
 - vii. Helping out at the show
 1. Backstage moving sets and props for the Stage Manager as back-stage crew member
 2. Help with make-up and/or chaperone backstage in the greenroom
 3. Helping with the box office, concessions, or ushering
 - c. We realize some families do not have the time or ability to volunteer. If you cannot volunteer for anything, we ask for a \$20 donation.
3. **ACTOR CONTRACT** – as an actor involved with this show, I agree to:
 - a. Pay my cast fee on time, or speak to the Director about alternative solution.
 - b. **Commit to this show, both rehearsals and performances.**
 - i. I understand that Prairie Playhouse’s policy states that if I drop out of the show after being cast, I will not be allowed to audition for future productions with Prairie Playhouse.
 - c. Arrive early enough to start rehearsal on-time (time on the schedule is start time not arrival time).
 - d. Pay attention and try my best.
 - e. Have mature behavior, clean language, and not smoke or drink alcohol in front of other cast or crew members.
 - f. Maintain good behavior back stage during performances including caring for other cast members.
 - g. Always have my script, and be prepared with pencil, water bottle, and snack if needed.
 - h. Memorize my lines and songs by the date listed on the Rehearsal Schedule.
 - i. Review lines, songs, and choreography outside rehearsal to fully learn.
 - j. Not chew gum during rehearsal. Non-messy snacks are fine, and water is always encouraged.
 - k. Approve all missed rehearsals with the Director.
 - l. Not miss more than 2 rehearsals total (any more need to be approved by Director), and make-up what is missed with another cast member (we do not do make-up rehearsals with any of the Direction team – send a video camera if necessary. In addition, do not ask the Director to work with you on missed rehearsal material).
 - m. Not miss rehearsals during tech week or performances (unless pre-approved with the Director).
 - n. Not use copied script or CD for any future performances however small. Any use of these materials outside of rehearsal benefit is a copyright violation and is not allowed. If in doubt, throw both away after the show closes.
 - o. HAVE FUN, make new friends, be friendly with all cast and crew members, and gain as much theater experience as you can!
