Number of paintings: 15

Total combined width of all paintings: 459 Inches (Unframed). This would seem to be enough for a solo exhibition, but I would gladly be part of a joint show.

The theme for my proposal is a collection of my experiences exploring the city around me. The paintings are a collection of urban cityscapes, architecture, and infrastructure in the bay area. When wandering through the city, various aspects catch my attention - light, distance, interesting combinations of shapes, lines, scale, and color all can inspire me to record what I am experiencing at that given time.

The city around me is what I see everyday, so there is a natural familiarity and visual relationship that develops. More specifically in the bay area, the way the infrastructure and architecture combine with strong light and shadow make for interesting compositions.

Some of my pieces are very direct depictions of a specific scene or thing. Others are a collage of sorts, combining multiple views and different times of day within the same painting - sometimes in an attempt to capture a large, wide space and/or feeling of a journey, with movement and time.

As to my process, I will make drawings and take written notes for colors of the scenes that interest me as I walk through the city. In some cases I will paint directly on the spot (plein air), but for larger works I will refer to the drawings and notes and construct the painting to a large extent in the computer. I will then use that as a primary basis for making the oil painting. If possible, I will bring the oil painting back to the original location and work on it further there.

In these pieces I want to immerse the viewer in my experience of a particular scene, place, or thing in hopes of offering a unique perspective that is aesthetically pleasing, but also captures what it was like to *be* there and notice what interested me about the place.
