Bidder further agrees to pay as liquidated damages the sum of \$350 for each consecutive day after the established substantial completion date or adjusted date as established by change order.

Bidding Requirements: In addition to the work required in the above Sections, this bid package overview includes, but is not limited to the following:

Provide all labor, materials and equipment necessary to furnish and install an operational plumbing system in accordance with the contract documents and adhering to the latest editions of the Idaho State Plumbing Code and all local and state codes.

This bid package includes, but is not limited to the following:

- Supply and install items noted on the plumbing fixture schedules including sinks, lavs, toilets, urinals, backflow preventers, floor sinks, floor drains, water heaters, drinking fountains, mixing valves, hose bibbs, trench drains and all items listed on plumbing schedules.
- Supply and install of all plumbing systems, items and accessories including roof drains, and overflow drains with final tie-in to drainage system, trim and piping. Include all pipe hangers, supports, pads, pipe insulation, waste and vent piping access doors and miscellaneous steel required.
- All required demolition of plumbing where shown.
- Sawcutting, core drilling, wall penetrations, floor penetrations, roof penetrations or trenching required for Plumbing systems.
- Concrete pour-back for all plumbing trenches.
- Underground and underslab rough-in.
- Backfill and compaction of plumbing trenches.
- Access frames and doors for plumbing valves or controls.
- Identification for plumbing piping and equipment.
- Roof hydrant.
- Water and drain connections to kitchen equipment.
- Plumbing pumps noted.
- Gas piping systems. From the meter.
- Condensate piping systems.
- Fire caulking and safing as required for this work.
- Fire stops as required for this work.
- Tie into site utilities within 5 feet of the building structure.
- Connection and testing at tie in from building structure piping to site utilities

All craning, hoisting, machinery or equipment required to complete the delivery and installation of this scope of work is the responsibility of this Contractor. It is this Contractors responsibility to provide resources to move materials and machinery.

The scope outlined above is to be used as a reference only and should not be considered exhaustive. It is the responsibility of the bidding Contractor to review all contract documents to provide a complete and responsive bid for their trade and include all items in accordance with the plans and specifications.

General Notes:

This Contractor will commit to allocating sufficient quantities of manpower, material and equipment to this project to meet the construction schedule established by the Construction Manager.

This Contractor will coordinate all activities with all other trades to allow for timely construction activities throughout the duration of the project.

This Contractor is to provide, install and remove any safety equipment required to perform this work.
