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NOTICE TO BIDDERS

North Cornwall Township will be accepting sealed bids for Highway Line Painting Work requiring an estimated 92,000 (+/-) Linear Feet of 4" Double Yellow Center and estimated 163,000 (+/-) Linear Feet of 4" Single White Edge Lines. Submitted Bids to be plainly marked on the outside envelope: "2021 TRAFFIC LINE PAINTING AND INTERSECTION MARKINGS".

All bids must be delivered to the Township office located at 320 S. 18th Street, Lebanon, Pa. 17042. Bids must be received by June 11, 2021 at 11:00 a.m. and will be opened and tallied at that time. It is anticipated that the Board of Supervisors will award the bids at their mid-month meeting held on June 15, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. North Cornwall Township reserves the right to reject any submitted bids.

2021 Traffic Line Painting and intersection markings proposal packets, including Bid Forms may be obtained at the office of the North Cornwall Township, 320 S. 18th Street, Lebanon, Pa. 17042.

The bidder shall honor the prices for a period of one (1) year from the date of the execution of the contract and/or as negotiated and illustrated in the contract agreement. By signing and submitting a bid, each Bidder shall be deemed to have consented in writing, within the meaning of 16 P.S. Section 18702 (e), to such extended date for the Contract to be awarded.

North Cornwall Township does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, age, family, and handicapped status in employment or the provision of services.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. All prices shall be based upon performing the work in accordance with the attached specifications, after receipt of a formal Notice to Proceed is issued by the Public Works Director.
2. Any alterations, erasures, additions to or omissions of required information in, or change of specifications or bidding schedule is done at the risk of the bidder and may result in rejection of his bid. In case a bidder finds discrepancies or omissions in or is in doubt as to the meaning of the specifications of bidding schedule, he should at once notify the North Cornwall Township Public work department who will reply to such questions in Official Supplement and copies will be sent simultaneously to all bidders.
3. All Bidders are responsible to see that their names appear in the Purchasing Department Office on the form recording the names of Prospective bidders, so that the bidders are assured of receiving pertinent bulletins which may be issued before the bids are opened.
4. All Bidders must be recognized contractors for the work specified and qualified to advise in its applications of use. The Bidder at any time requested, must satisfy the Public Works Department and/or Administrative Offices that they have the requisite organization, capital, plant, stock, ability and experience to satisfactorily execute the contract in accordance with the provisions of the contract in which he is interested.
5. Submitting a Proposal when it is intended to sublet the contract is cause for rejection of your bid, cancellation of the contract.
6. It is agreed by the parties hereto that wherever the word Purchasing Agent or the pronoun in place thereof occurs in the Articles of Agreement of Specifications, it is hereby expressly understood that the Purchasing Agent is acting only under the authority of and subject to the approval of the Administrative Management and/or Public Works Department.
7. Bids for all or part where bids are not qualified by specific limitations, the Township reserves the right to award all or any of the items according to its best interest, unless otherwise required in the Specifications.
8. In case of error in the extension of prices, the unit price shall govern.
9. It is mutually agreed and understood that if at any time, the Purchasing Agent or his authorized representative shall be of the opinion that the contract or any part thereof, is unnecessarily delayed or that the rate of progress or delivery is unsatisfactory or that the contractor is willfully violating any of the contract requirements or conditions or is executing the same in

bad faith, he shall therefore have the power to take whatever action he may deem necessary to complete work or delivery herein described or any part thereof so charged shall be deducted from and paid to the Township out of such money as may be due to the Contractor by virtue of this Agreement, and the Bondsmen to be held liable for any balance due at the completion of the contract.

10. The contract will not be awarded to any corporation, firm, or individual who has failed in any former contract with North Cornwall Township to perform work or deliver of guarantee or the time consumed in the completion.
11. It is expressly understood and agreed that the inspection of materials and workmanship by the Purchasing or Testing Laboratory will in no way lessen the responsibility of the contract or release him from obligations to perform and deliver the Township sound or satisfactory work or materials. The Contractor agrees to pay the cost of all tests for defective work or materials and to allow the cost to be deducted from any money due him from the Township; otherwise bondsmen in this case are liable for satisfactory work or materials. The Contractor agrees to pay the cost of all tests for defective materials and to allow the cost to be deducted from any money due him from the County; otherwise bondsmen in this case are liable for satisfactory completion of the Contract.
12. When the contract has been duly signed and the contract bond covering the same approved, then and not before the contractor may secure instructions from the Purchasing Agent pertaining to the procedure of the work or delivery.
13. If more than one bid is offered by any one party or in the name of his clerk, partners, or other person, all such bids may be rejected. However, a party who has quoted prices on materials to a bidder is not thereby disqualified from quoting prices to other bidders or from submitting a bid directly for the materials or work.
14. The Public Works Director, Township Manager, and Township Supervisors reserve the right to reject any and all bids or specifications when deemed to the best interest of the County and also to purchase any part, or none of the materials specified.
15. All terms, rebates, and discounts shall be considered to be offered effective as of the date of payment by the Township notwithstanding anything to the contrary expressed by the Bidder in his bid.
16. The Township will reject any or all work that does not meet the specifications.
17. If applicable, the material and equipment shall be delivered to the Township of North Cornwall, Lebanon County, Pennsylvania; all prices quoted shall be F.O.B., North Cornwall Township, 320 S. 18th Street, Lebanon, Pa. 17042.
18. The successful bidder shall be required to furnish a performance bond with a proper Surety

Company. If the contract price is less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) no bond will be required. If the amount of the contract exceeds \$10,000.00 the Contractor's Bond must be sufficient surety in the amount of 100% of the amount of the said contract guaranteeing the performance of the contract within ten (20) days after the Contract has been awarded.

19. Awarded Contractor shall submit Certificate of Insurance, listing the Township as additional insured, with the following minimum acceptable limits of liability per occurrence: General Aggregate: \$2,000,000, General Liability: \$1,000,000, Personal Liability: \$1,000,000, and Automotive Liability: \$1,000,000.
20. The party or parties bidding upon this proposal to whom the award or awards shall be made will be required to enter into a contract with North Cornwall Township, within ten (20) days of notification by the Purchasing Agent. Failure to do so, the award may be canceled and the check submitted shall be forfeited and become the absolute property of North Cornwall Township. It is also understood by the successful bidder that it, he or they, under the conditions herein imposed, relinquish absolutely all right to recover said amount or any part thereof by suit or mandamus.
21. The Bidder or Bidders to whom the contract is awarded agrees to relinquish North Cornwall Township from all suits or action of any nature or description brought against them for or on account of the use of patents, appliances, products or processes.
22. The North Cornwall Township Supervisors, however, at their discretion, may extend the time for the completion of this contract, if prevented by strikes of employees or by reason of it being impossible to procure the necessary material, equipment, etc.
23. All bids must be made on Proposal blanks attached to these specifications and made part thereof, and must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, directed to the Public Works Department, and plainly marked on the outside envelope: "2021 TRAFFIC LINE PAINTING AND INTERSECTION MARKINGS".
24. BIDDERS MUST WRITE OR PRINT THE FIGURES WITH INK OR A TYPEWRITER.
25. A Proposal which is incomplete, obscure, conditional or unbalanced or which contains additions not called for or irregularities of any kind may be rejected as informal. A Proposal which contains alterations or which is not accompanied by the required certified check, cashier's check, bid bond, or trust company treasurer's check shall be rejected.
26. The awarded contractor must submit all above documents within 20 days after the contract has been awarded by the North Cornwall Township Supervisors, and the contractor has been notified by the Township's Public Works Department. Upon review and verification of all submitted contract documents, North Cornwall Township will issue a Notice to Proceed, including all signed documents, to the contractor.

27. The North Cornwall Township Supervisors reserve the right to reject any or all proposals or any part or parts thereof as may deem to the best interest of the North Cornwall Township. The North Cornwall Township Supervisors also reserve the right to cancel the award at any time before the execution of the contract.

SIGNING OF THE AGREEMENT AND BOND

1. The successful bidder or bidders will be required to sign the Articles of Agreement and Bond as follows:

A. If you are trading as an INDIVIDUAL -- all copies of the Articles of Agreement and Bond must be signed by the Individual to whom the award is made and the signature must be witnessed by the same witness.

B. If you are trading as a PARTNERSHIP -- all copies of the Articles of Agreement and Bond must be signed by every partner comprising the partnership regardless of the number and these signatures must be witnessed by the same witness.

C. If you are trading as a CORPORATION - all copies of the Articles of Agreement and Bond must be signed by the President (or Vice President) and attested by the Secretary or Assistant Secretary and the Corporate Seal must be affixed to all copies.

2. The successful bidder is required to enter into a written contract with North Cornwall Township and furnish a Contractor's Bond, conditioned for the full performance of the contract with sufficient surety in the amount of the contract unless the amount of the contract is less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), in which case no bond will be required. If the amount of the contract exceeds \$10,000.00 the Contractor's Bond must be sufficient surety in the amount of 100% of the amount of the contract. Any surety co-signing the Contractor's Bond must be an incorporated surety licensed to do business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as per U.S. Department of the Treasury Department Circular 570 and naming as Oblige "North Cornwall Township".

A bond with surety must be furnished at the time of signing of the contract. The Township reserve the right to reject any Bond furnished where it is to the best interest of the County to do so.

The Township requires Powers of Attorney attached to Bonds to be dated currently, sealed and executed by a proper live (not facsimile) signature.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Description

This work is for providing the required materials, including but not limited to Waterborne and Solvent Based Type II, Rapid Dry Traffic Paint and Glass Beads, in accordance with the latest PennDOT Specifications and Version of Publication 408, for the application of traffic lines on the specified County Roads and Bridges.

Material

The contractor will supply the required paint and glass beads and will be responsible for insuring the acceptability of materials. The contractor will be responsible for coordinating delivery and storage of the materials to a suitable storage area also provided by the contractor. North Cornwall Township will not be responsible for any excess materials after completion of the specified work.

All work including the application, storage and handling of the paint and glass beads shall be in accordance with latest edition PennDOT Publication 408 Section 962.

North Cornwall Township reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantities at any time during the contract period.

Construction

All work including equipment, application rates, protection of painted surfaces, etc. shall be provided in accordance with the latest edition PennDOT Publication 408 Specification.

North Cornwall Township will be responsible for the cleaning the pavement surface prior to application of paint if required. The contractor shall not paint any roadway unless the surface is in a clean and dry condition. North Cornwall Township will not be responsible for damaged or defective work caused by undesirable weather conditions.

North Cornwall Township will not be responsible for any traffic control patterns or labor necessary to install such patterns. Contractor is responsible for traffic control in accordance with the latest edition PennDOT Publication 408 and PennDOT Pub. 213. North Cornwall Township will also not be responsible for any claims associated with over-spraying of paint onto vehicles or private property.

Road Locations

Roads, locations and approximate mileage, are provided on the attached North Cornwall Township Map and Road Inventory List. The Township reserves the right to append the list of work locations provided they are located within the limits of North Cornwall Township.

Measurement & Payment

Measurement and payment of the work, including all materials, shall be based on a Linear Foot basis. Double Yellow shall be paid lineal foot for two four inch yellow lines. Single white shall be paid lineal foot for one four inch white line.

Contract Duration

The said contract prices on the proposal sheet shall remain firm from the date of execution of the contract until December 31 of the same year. The successful contractor shall have equipment and personnel capable of substantially completing all work within fifteen (15) working days. All specified work shall be completed by September 24, 2021, unless otherwise directed by North Cornwall Township.

Work Scheduling

The contractor shall coordinate the scheduling of work with the North Cornwall Township's Public works Director or Highway Foreman.
