The “Article” shall include the manuscript and all sub-parts therein, including figures, tables, multimedia, supplementary material, summary statement, and abstract, if submitted. The “Author” is the corresponding author who will act on the behalf of all authors of the manuscript. To enable the broadest dissemination of the Article, the Author and the Journal agree as follows:

1. License to the Journal

The Author retains the copyright and grants to the Journal the worldwide, irrevocable, nonexclusive, and royalty-free rights as follows:

- 1.1 The Journal may publish, reproduce, distribute, display, transmit, archive, and preserve the Article or portions thereof in any manner and in any format through any medium now in existence or developed in the future.
- 1.2 The Journal may prepare translations and abstracts and other adaptations or derivatives of the Article.
- 1.3 The Journal may use the Author’s name, likeness, and institutional affiliation in connection with any use of the Article and in promoting the Article or the Journal.
- 1.4 The Journal may authorize third-party entities to include the Article and its bibliographic information in academic databases and discovery services.
- 1.5 The Journal may without further permission from the Author transfer, assign, or sublicense the rights that the Journal has pursuant to this Agreement.
- 1.6 The Journal may publish the Article with a Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial license to maximize the dissemination. Information about the license is available at <https://creativecommons.org/licenses/by/4.0/> and detailed at <https://creativecommons.org/licenses/by/4.0/legalcode>.
- 1.7 This License of rights to the Journal takes effect immediately. If the Journal does not publish the Article, this license will terminate upon written notification of the Journal to the Author. To the extent that moral rights may apply to the Article, this Agreement does not affect the Author’s moral rights in the Article.

2. Rights of the Author

The Author is entitled to the following rights:

- 2.1 The Author may distribute the published Article in any format after is publication in the Journal.
- 2.2 If the published Article includes edits and other contributions by the staff of the Journal, the Author has the right to use such edits and contributions.

2.3 The Author may use the Article in connection with the Author’s teaching, conference presentations, lectures, other scholarly works, and academic and professional activities.

3. Responsibility of the Author

- 4.3 The Author owns the copyright in the Article and has full power to enter into this Agreement and to convey the rights herein granted.
- 4.4 The Article has not been published before, constitutes the Author’s own original work, does not violate any existing copyright, and is free from all liens and claims.
- 4.5 The Article does not defame, invade the privacy of, violate the civil rights of, or infringe upon the rights of any individual or third parties.
- 4.6 The Author agrees to indemnify and hold the Journal harmless from any breach of the aforementioned representations.
