

Technology Agreement

St. Michael Lutheran School

St. Michael Lutheran School students have many opportunities to use technology to enrich their learning. As in all areas of life at school, students are expected to demonstrate Christian values, responsibility, respect, and good judgment when using computers and other technology, both on and off campus. The staff at St. Michael, in partnership with the families it serves, educates the students on the differences between appropriate and inappropriate material and trusts the student to differentiate should the filtering fail or if the student is using a computer elsewhere. Teachers will go over rules and expectations throughout the year and tailor the learning to the age of the student.

In order to use the school's technology, St. Michael students and parents agree to accept the following responsibilities:

- Use technology at school for educational purposes and do nothing to change the computer without permission.
- Be safe online by not giving out personal information.
- Immediately tell the teacher if inappropriate material appears on the computer. Failure to report it or sharing the information with other students may result in disciplinary action.
- Do not try to access anything that does not reflect our Christian values.
- Use appropriate language and show respect to others when communicating electronically.
- Protect their privacy by not sharing their password with other students.
- Respect files or work that belongs to others; never changing or erasing the work of others.
- Respect copyright laws by not using work created by others without permission.
- Not use personal devices during the school day unless directed by a teacher for a specific reason or as a learning device.
- Should the student make use of the computer system in an unacceptable way or damage the computer or other devices, the student/family is responsible for the cost of the repair or replacement. St. Michael Lutheran School may cancel the student's access, take other disciplinary measures or, in some cases, contact the appropriate authorities.

Student and Parent must sign and date on the reverse side of this agreement before the student will be able to utilize the technology devices at St. Michael.

Repair Costs for Chromebooks/iPads

Due to the nature of technology, it is of utmost importance for teachers and students to take care of the devices used at St. Michael. Students will be trained in how to properly care for these items but should damage arise due to misuse, the individual will be responsible for the repair or replacement costs of the device. Should this be necessary, the students and parents will be informed immediately. It is understood that this list is not comprehensive and damages that incur will still be the responsibility of the student/guardian responsible. Our desire is for all of our students to be wise stewards of the resources they are entrusted with.
