

# NCAA Eligibility Student Checklist

(adapted from NCAA Eligibility Center)

## Grade 9—Plan Ahead!

- Ask your counselor for a list of NCAA Core Courses to make sure you are eligible

## Grade 10—Register!

- Register with the NCAA Eligibility Center @ [eligibilitycenter.org](https://eligibilitycenter.org)
- Talk with your counselor during course selection to make sure all classes meet eligibility

## Grade 11-Study!

- Meet with your counselor to ensure you are on track to graduate on time
- Meet with your counselor to plan your standardized testing timeline (SAT and ACT exams)
- Provide NCAA with standardized test scores by using code 9999
- Request transcript at the end of school year through NCAA eligibility Center account— once requested the Guidance office will upload!

## Grade 12– Graduate!

- Finish taking standardized tests (if necessary)
- Provide NCAA with standardized test scores by using code 9999
- Request your final amateurism certification after April 1 through your NCAA Eligibility Center account
- Request final transcript through NCAA Eligibility Center account with proof of graduation
