I am aware that:

- In Summer, FLAS awards will cover up to \$5,000 in tuition and fees for both graduate and undergraduate Fellows. In Academic Year, the fellowship will cover up to \$18,000 (\$9,000/semester) in tuition and fees for graduate fellows, and up to \$10,000 (\$5,000/semester) in tuition and fees for undergraduate fellows.
- I am responsible for paying room, board, and other living expenses from my FLAS stipend or personal funds, and that such costs will be deducted from my FLAS stipend if they are included in the program cost and are paid to the host institution by the OSU Office of Study Abroad or by CLAS.
- Summer FLAS Fellows may receive a travel award of up to \$1,000. US government regulations require that fellowship recipients comply with the provisions of the Fly America Act. Specifically, **all tickets for overseas flights must be purchased on a US carrier, regardless of cost, unless the traveler is able to meet exemption requirements.** Reimbursements will be processed upon return and presentation of proper documentation.
