

Consent and Disclosure for Affidavit of Support

I acknowledge that I have received and thoroughly reviewed the information in the instructions to Form I-864 concerning the obligations of a sponsor in completing an Affidavit of Support on behalf of a sponsored immigrant. I agree that I have been advised of all of the consequences of signing an Affidavit of Support for the sponsored immigrant. Before signing the Affidavit of Support, I have read it and I understand my obligations under it.

I understand that in any representation of two parties by the same lawyer at the same time, conflicts of interest are possible. I agree that no dispute now exists between me and the sponsored immigrant. I understand that if any conflict of interest concerning the Affidavit of Support arises, Ryan, Swanson & Cleveland, PLLC would not be able to represent both me and the sponsored immigrant, unless both consent in writing to continue the joint representation and the firm decides that under the circumstances it can fulfill its professional responsibilities to both parties.

I understand that I have a right to consult another attorney before signing this consent form and/or the Affidavit of Support. By signing below, I agree that I have had adequate time to obtain advice from another attorney and have either consulted an independent attorney, or have decided not to do so.

I understand that I must file Form I-865 to notify U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) of a change in my address, as specified in Form I-864. I do not expect Ryan, Swanson & Cleveland, PLLC to have any responsibility regarding the filing of any Change of Address form on my behalf.
