



Estimated Expense Budget 2020-2021 Academic Year

Following is an estimate of the cost of attendance for each student. This budget is used in calculating expenses for financial aid and loan applications, for determining the economic need of international students, and is provided to assist JST students in estimating their budgetary requirements for the academic year. As you will note, this budget is for the ***nine-month academic year only***. As these costs are **only estimates**, individual budgets may vary considerably. Keep this document for your reference.

For the purposes of loan applications, allowable expenses include tuition, fees, room, board (food), books, transportation, medical/dental and personal expenses related to school attendance. Consumer debt payments, car payments, charitable gifts, legal fees, life insurance, etc., are not considered allowable expenses.
