1. Header Section

- **League Information:**
 - League Name, Division, and Game ID (if applicable)
 - Teams, Date, Time, and Venue
- **Officials:**
 - Umpires and Scorers

2. Lineups

- **Batting Order:**
 - Player Names, Numbers, and Positions
 - Additional space for stats like season batting average or league rankings

3. Standardized Innings Grid

- **Player Tracking:**
 - Rows for batting order
 - Columns for each inning (1–9 or extras)
 - Standardized symbols for play outcomes (e.g., SO for strikeout, HR for home run)
- **Team Totals:**
 - Runs, hits, and errors per inning

4. Pitching Section

- For each pitcher:

- Innings pitched, runs allowed, earned runs, strikeouts, walks, and pitch count
- Space to note substitutions and relievers

5. League-Specific Features

- **Special Rules:**
 - Space for recording rule applications (e.g., mercy rule, extra inning rules)
- **Player of the Game:**
 - Section for noting standout performances

6. Game Summary

- Line Score:
 - Runs per inning with totals
- Space for additional notes, highlights, or unusual events.
