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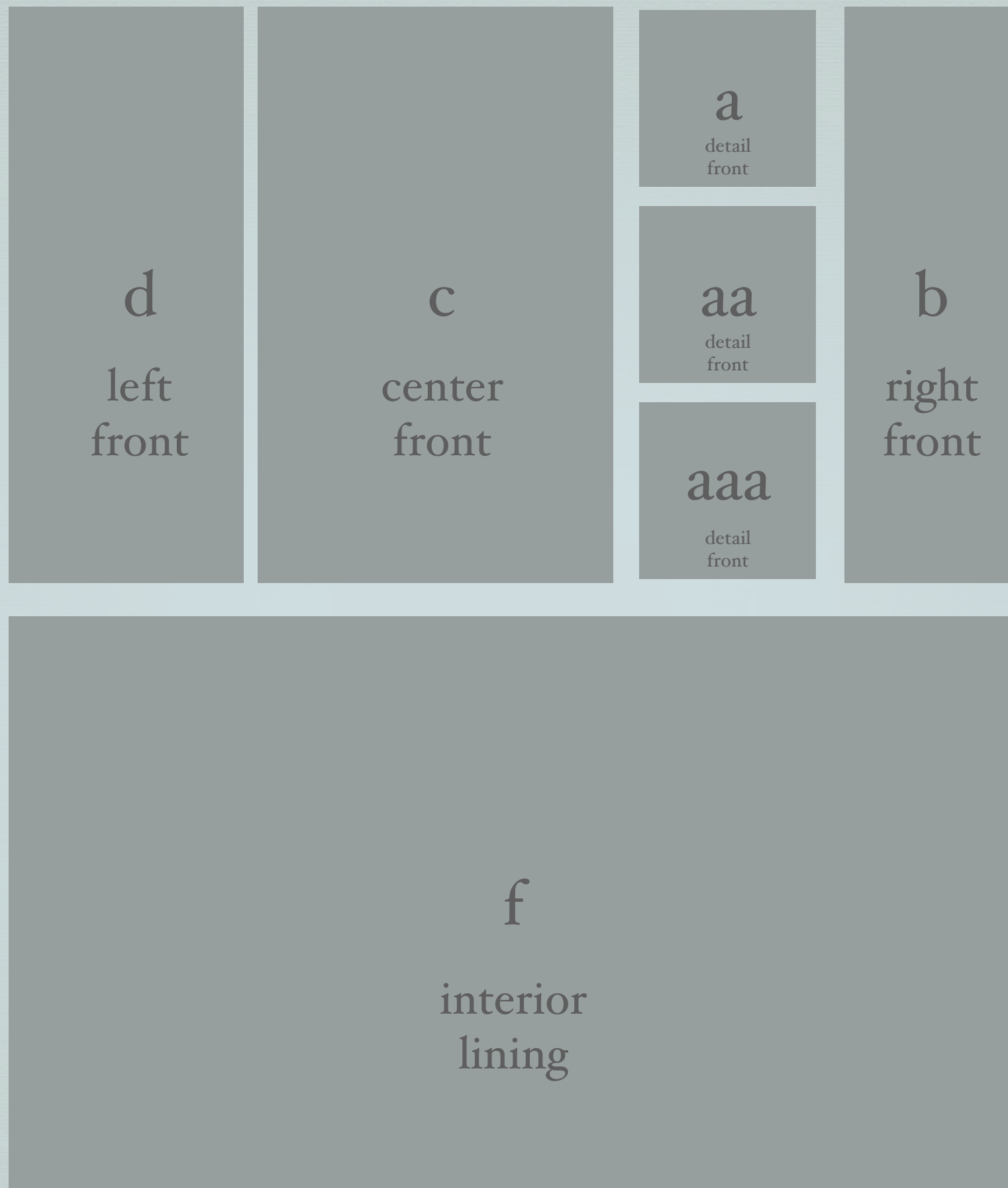
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f = 18" x 10" (cut 1)
e = 5" x 10" (cut 4)
d = 4.75" x 10" (cut 1)
c = 8" x 10" (cut 1)
b = 3.25" x 10" (cut 1)
a = 3.75" x 3.75" (cut 3)





One Inch Mini Patchwork Binder Cover Instructions

Materials:

**1/2 yard to 3/4
yard
of scrap fabric
in coordinating
colors**

**10" x 18" cut of
batting**

1. Stitch (a), (aa) and (aaa) together to form a rectangle.
2. Stitch the (a) rectangle to the (b) rectangle down one long side.
3. Stitch the (ab) rectangle to the (c) rectangle down one long side.
4. Stitch the (abc) rectangle to the (d) rectangle to form one large rectangle.
5. Stitch two (e) rectangles right sides together, down one long side. Open, flip right side out and press to create a pocket panel. Repeat with other two (e) rectangles to create second pocket.
6. Place the (f) rectangle atop of the batting.
7. Position one (e) pocket on each end of the (f) + batting rectangle.
8. Position (abcd) rectangle atop of the (f) panel + pockets with right sides together.
9. Pin in place and stitch around two long ends and one short end.
10. Trim excess fabric. Taking care not to trim stitching.
11. Flip cover right side out and position one pocket on the front and one pocket on the rear.
12. Stitch the open end closed and flip the pocket over to the front to hide stitches.
13. Press and insert binder.
