How to register for the ACE Program

1

Login to Adobe Education Exchange <https://edex.adobe.com/> & create your profile (Adobe Spark users may use their existing Spark user ID & password) else create a new one.

2

Click on bit.ly/adobecreativeeducator

3

Level 1 - Adobe Creative Educator → Click on Start Level 1.

4

Complete a 3 hours course on "Creativity for All" → Click on Continue Learning.
Move through each step in the order it is presented.

5

Assignment - In assignment section, make any 1 assignment on "How will you support your students' creativity?" OR "What is your goal as a creative educator?" using any Adobe tool Adobe Spark (Post Only), Adobe Illustrator or Adobe Photoshop. Put the shareable link of your creation in section provided.

6

Peer Review - In order to complete the course, simply click on the work of any 3 participants' projects mentioned in "Peer review section" & give your constructive feedback.

7

After course completion, course instructors will begin reviewing the coursework of all participating members. Once your coursework is approved, you will receive a digital badge and an email with a link to download your course certificate for 3 hours of accredited professional learning. Please allow up to two weeks for this process.

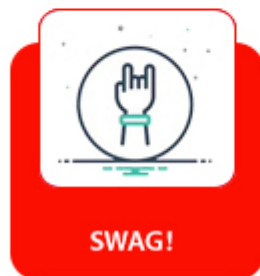
