

## Bill of Rights Project Sheet

- You and your group members will become experts over one of the first ten amendments
- You will create a visual aid in order to help your classmates easily remember the Bill of Rights
- Your group will be responsible for one amendment only; be sure you completely understand it and **can teach it to others!**
  - Each project should include
    - Your amendment number (large and easily seen)
    - Main idea of your amendment
    - A clue or trick to help remember the amendment
  - Each project should be
    - Large and Clear
    - Colorful and Neat
    - Informational and Concise
- Group Roles
  - Each member of the group is responsible for the group project
    - Suggested Roles
      - Writer/Artist- neatly creates the group poster
      - Fact Checker- make sure information is accurate and easy to understand
      - Speaker – presents project; be able to answer questions about your project
    - **Each group member may help complete all three tasks**
