- **No author is required to provide any information that they do not feel comfortable disclosing.**
- **Information gathered in this form is private and secure.** Cell Press will only use the data for aggregate reporting. We will not share it with external parties. If you choose to publish an inclusion and diversity statement in your paper, our aim is to ensure that individual authors remain anonymous, as you will see in the examples below.
