	Each body paragraph in the rough draft contains at least 1 piece of textual evidence which support the claims and analysis made in the essay.	
	The textual evidence is drawn from the literature and supports the analysis and claims made in the essay.	
	Each piece of evidence includes a properly formatted parenthetical citation (MLA format) which also matches an entry on the works cited page.	
	Each body paragraph includes appropriate transitions that increase the coherence of the essay.	
	A works cited page is present and an attempt is made at a correct citation.
