## a letter from the pastor

Over the years, we've become accustomed to giving up certain things for Lent, little sacrifices to help atone for our sins. For example, candy, desserts, snacks etc. As children, we couldn't wait for Easter Sunday to arrive because in addition to celebrating Jesus being raised from the dead, we might also have a new outfit plus we could go back to having the sweet things we gave up for Lent. But as adults, we should remember that Lent is a call to conversion, to making permanent changes in our lives – to turn away from whatever needs to be changed and looking forward and moving forward to become that new person. It may not happen this Lent and not even next Lent. But when we take one step each Lent, then change comes gradually and before we know it, we're on the road to becoming saints.

To help us on our Lenten journey, the Church suggests the two penitential practices of Fasting and ABSTINENCE. Fasting pertains to all who are between the ages of 18 and 59 and asks the person to limit oneself to one full meal and 2 lighter meals and asks the person to avoid eating between meals. Abstinence pertains to all who have reached 14 years of age to abstain from eating meat on the Fridays of Lent including Good Friday. All are encouraged to participate in these practices even though those who do not fall into the age categories. Those with medical conditions are not bound to the practices of During the Lenten Season, the Church recommends the three practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Fasting and Abstinence. Pope Francis also offered some ideas for fasting, please see page 6 of this bulletin.

One excellent prayerful experience during Lent is to make or pray the Stations of the Cross. At Holy Name of Jesus, we pray the Stations on the Fridays of Lent at 7:30 PM. You can also pray the Stations by yourself simply by walking from Station to Station and as you stop at each station, spend a minute or two thinking, praying, or meditating on that station and continue the journey for the remaining stations. You can also follow one of the many printed versions. Mass is celebrated at 9:00 AM Mondays through Friday and the rosary is prayed every morning at 9:30 AM immediately following Mass. On Wednesday morning, there is also exposition and prayer before the Blessed Sacrament.

The **Monday of Holy Week, April 11**, is now referred to as **Reconciliation Monday** throughout the Diocese of Rockville Centre. All parishes are asked to participate and offer Confession from 2:00 PM to 4 PM and again from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM. The same opportunity is offered in the Archdiocese of New York and the Diocese of Brooklyn.

This week we take up The Catholic Relief Services Collection to reveal Christ's love to our brothers and sisters in need. This collection helps six Catholic agencies to provide relief and support for struggling communities and to work for peace and reconciliation among our marginalized brothers and sisters here and around the world. Please prayerfully consider how you can support the collection.

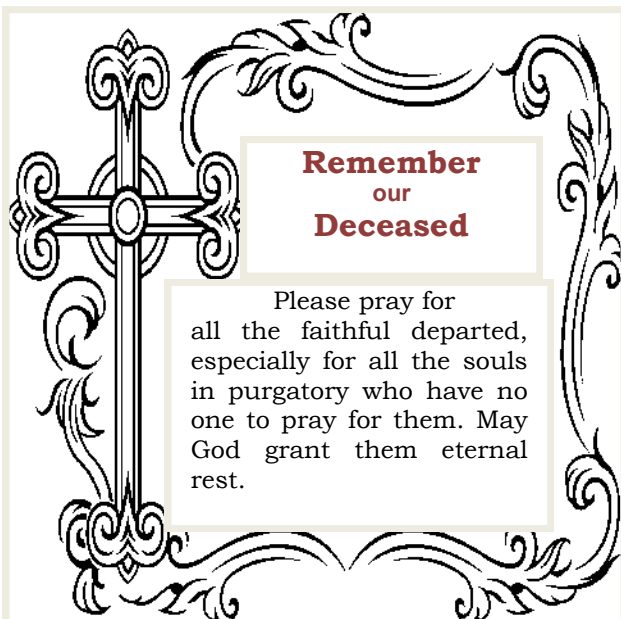

## The Quilt Holes

As I faced my Maker at the last judgment, I knelt before the Lord along with all the other souls. Before each of us laid our lives like the squares of a quilt in many piles; an angel sat before each of us sewing our quilt squares together into a tapestry that was our life.

As my angel took each piece of cloth off the pile, I noticed how ragged and empty each of my quilt squares was. They were filled with giant holes. My gaze dropped to the ground in shame. Quilt holes! I hadn't had all the earthly fortunes. I had love in my life and laughter. But there had also been trials of illness and wealth, and false accusations that took from me my world, as I knew it. I had to start over many times. I spent many nights on my knees in prayer, asking for help and guidance in my life.

I rose and slowly lifted the combined quilt squares of my life, with the holes, to the light. An awe-filled gasp filled the air. I gazed around at the others who stared at me with wide eyes.

Then, I looked upon the quilt tapestry before me. Light flooded the many holes, creating an image: the face of Christ. Then our Lord stood before me, with warmth and love in His eyes.

He said, 'Every time you gave over your life to Me, it became My life, My hardships, and My struggles.'

'Each point of light in your life is when you stepped aside and let Me shine through, until there was more of Me than there was of you.'

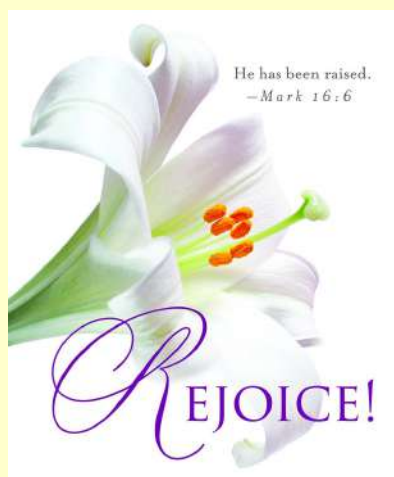
