<b>Can I download Safari e-books?</b>	NO – Safari e-books are not downloadable.
<b>How many users can access Safari Books Online at the same time?</b>	JMU shares 100 seats to Safari Books Online with other VIVA institutions. ProQuest will open temporary seats per title upon request; ask a librarian for more information.
<b>Can I print pages from Safari e-books?</b>	YES – use the print icon in the top left corner of the reader window.
<b>Do Safari e-books contain the CD/DVD-ROM content sometimes found in their print versions?</b>	If this content is available it will display on an EXTRAS tab in the book's table of contents.

<b>Is there a mobile website?</b>	YES – read Safari content on your mobile device here: <a href="http://m.proquest.safaribooksonline.com">http://m.proquest.safaribooksonline.com</a>  Patrons must authenticate as JMU users – how to <a href="#">connect to library resources</a> from off campus.
<b>Is there a mobile app?</b>	NO
<b>What mobile devices work?</b>	Safari is compatible with Android, BlackBerry, iOS, and Windows devices and many popular eReaders like Kindle and Nook.
<b>Can I download Safari e-books to mobile devices?</b>	NO – Safari e-books are not downloadable but the Safari platform supports mobile devices.
