WHY TIGERS?

When The University of Memphis first fielded a football team in the fall of 1912, no one had selected a nickname for the squad. Early references to the football team tabbed them only as the Blue and Gray Warriors of West Tennessee Normal School.

After the final game of the 1914 season, there was a student parade. During this event, several Normal students shouted, "We fight like Tigers".

The nickname was born.

More and more the nickname "Tigers" was used, particularly in campus publications. But it did not catch on with the newspapers downtown. They continued to use "Normals" or the "Blue and Gray" when referring to the University.

Under Coach Lester Barnard in 1922, Normal's football team gave a ring of truth to that old student yell about Tigers. The team adopted a motto- "Every Man A Tiger" and went on to score 174 points while allowing their opponents just 29 points.

In the late 1920s, student publications and downtown newspapers began referring to the football team as the "Teachers" or "Tutors". The Tiger nickname would return. But not until 1939 was it initially adopted as the official nickname for the University of Memphis.

HARASSMENT/DISCRIMINATION POLICY

It is against university policy to harass or to discriminate against any member of the University community on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, age, disability, and/or veteran status. Harassment is reprehensible and will not be tolerated by the University. It is prohibited by University policy, Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 as amended, Title XI of the Educational Amendments of 1972, and other applicable law. Violation of these acts may subject the University and/or individuals to disciplinary action and may have legal consequences

Sexual harassment is especially serious when it threatens relationships between teacher and student or superior and subordinate. The University does not tolerate behavior between or among members of the University community that creates an unacceptable work or educational environment.

Sexual harassment is defined as unwelcome sexual advances, request for sexual favors and other verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature when submission to such conduct is explicitly or implicitly a term of condition of the individual's employment decisions, evaluation, reward, or work performance. Sexual harassment is verbal, visual, and/or physical.

Racial harassment/discrimination includes, but is not limited to, objectionable epithets, threatened or actual physical harm or abuse, or other intimidating or insulting conduct directed against the individual because of his/her race, color, or national origin.

Harassment or discrimination on the basis of religion, disability, or other protected status includes any conduct which has the purpose of reasonably foreseeable effects of interfering with an individual's academic efforts, employment, or participation in institutionally sponsored activities.

LIMITED TOBACCO USE ON CAMPUS

In 2011 a tobacco-free initiative was originally proposed by SGA, which enacted a resolution calling for a smoke-free campus. Similar resolutions were passed by the Faculty and Staff Senates. Building on these developments, the University's Policy Review Board approved a comprehensive policy to limit the use of tobacco on all U of M campuses by faculty, staff, students, contractors and visitors. The complete policy can be viewed at memphis.edu/tobacco, but key components include:

- Tobacco use is not permitted in any UofM-owned or leased property, including grounds, vehicles and buildings. The only exception is residential rental properties governed by tenant leases.
- Several areas on the main, Park Avenue (South Campus), Lambuth, Law School and Millington campuses have been designated where the use of tobacco products is permitted. These sites are noted via links on the Designated Areas page on the following website: memphis.edu/tobacco.

Directory Information

"Directory Information" is defined as: the student's name, U-Number, address, telephone listing, e-mail address, major field of study, date of birth, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height of members of athletic teams, dates of attendance, degrees and awards received, the most recent previous educational agency or institution attended by the student, the student's enrollment status (number of enrolled hours, full-time or part-time status), the student's classification(level), University student-employment status, and cumulative earned hours.

Restricted Release of Directory Information

After registering for courses, a student may request that directory information not be released. The student can request the restriction either by visiting the Registrar's Office and completing an official request form, or by logging into <https://iam.memphis.edu> and selecting the option.

Access to Records

To gain access, the student must request the custodian of the records to allow perusal of the education record according to University Policy UM1248, Privacy of Education Records (Compliance with FERPA). Students may contact the Registrar's Office if assistance is needed in identifying the custodian of the record in question.

Review, Amend, Consent to Release Records

Students and eligible parents have the right to review the education records, request amendments to the record, file a complaint related to the University's compliance with the requirements of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), and provide consent form release of personally identifiable information according to the University's Compliance policy.

Release of non-Directory, personally identifiable student education records to any party other than those specified by FERPA (e.g., another institution at which the student seeks or intends to enroll) is not permitted without the student's written consent.

Academic year calendars record the major activity dates (class start/end dates, exam dates, and commencement) for each term and its parts. Each academic year begins with the Fall term and ends at the conclusion of the Summer term. Students wanting specific registration, add/drop, fee payment, etc., dates and deadlines for a recent or upcoming term should review the Dates & Deadlines calendar for that term.

Note: On all academic calendars, the abbreviation, POT, stands for Part(s) of Term.

At the University of Memphis, the Academic Year is divided into three terms or semesters-- Fall, Spring, and Summer. Each term consists of several Parts of Term (POT). When registering for a term, you may register for courses in any one or combination of the POTs.

What's the difference between one POT and another?

The primary differences between one POT and another have to do with POT lengths (starting and ending dates) and lengths of class periods. It's important to remember that the same course offered in any POT requires the same minimum amount of class time as when it is offered in another POT. Also, the credit is the same. Thus, HMSE 1100 taken in the Pre Summer-POT is the equal of HMSE 1100 taken in the Fall Full POT or the Spring 2nd Half POT, and so on.

Some POTs--Regents, 1st Teacher, and 2nd Teacher--have a purpose of their own, so they are different from the other POTs in ways other than calendar days and meeting times.
