New York egg prices are unchanged on all sizes. California eggs are unchanged for Jumbo, down 10 cents for Extra Large and Large, and 6 cents higher for smaller sizes. Regional prices are unchanged. The undertone is steady. Demand is mostly moderate. Offerings are light to moderate. Supplies are moderate for current trade needs. Market activity is moderate. Breaking stock offerings are light; breaking schedules are normal to at times reduced. Spent fowl offerings are moderate for the light to moderate demand.

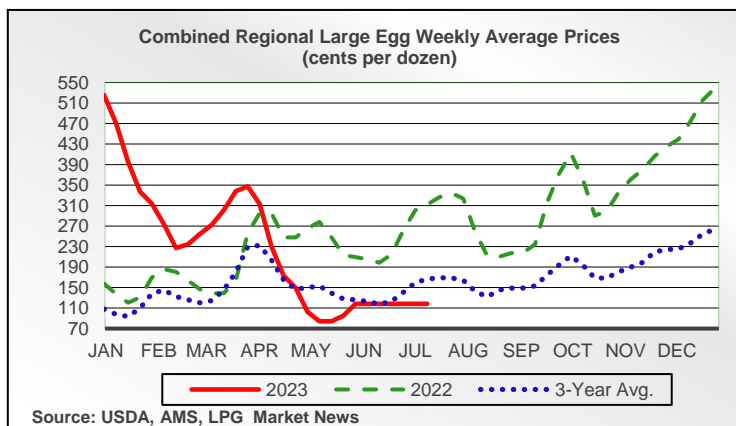
