If a classroom has more than one teacher, each teacher should take one half of the class to plan children's goals. Children should have a goal each month, so a goal for every child is not needed every week. For example Classroom A has 16 preschoolers with two teachers. Each teacher is responsible to plan goals for 8 children. In this case each teacher would plan a goal for 2 children per week. After four weeks (or one month) each of the 16 children will have had a goal and activity intentionally planned for him/her.

On this form there is room for 8 children's goal, you can add more rows or take rows away.
